Description of Licenced Activity: Beach Licence for the use of the foreshore and the floor of the sea (Pursuant to the section 11 of the Beach Control Act 1956)

Observations and Comments:

A group of men were seen on Little Goat Island. They alleged that they were fixing their geotechnical equipment as it was damaged at sea. Mr (name redacted), a representative from NHL (the sub-contractor) stated that CHEC gave him the go ahead to commence drilling activities. He confirmed a phone call made by (name redacted) to NEPA on Thursday 31 July 2014 that CHEC had commenced drilling activities on the eastern end of the harbor. He stated that marker buoys were placed at the coordinates on the eastern end of Little Goat Island as outlined in the permit. However, no such buoys were found upon surveying the area.

CONCLUSION

Of the 30 conditions listed above 7 had full compliance, 6 had non-compliance, 8 were not assessed and 9 were not applicable.

Therefore compliance was 54%.

- There were no CHEC representatives on site to issue a warning notice to.
- Drilling commenced prior to submission of requisite documents. Several conditions are in breach because several documents were not submitted.
- No marker buoys were observed though Mr Hill stated that they were put in place to mark drilling areas.
- All signs placed in and around the Goat Islands were not observed.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Ask that a CHEC representative be present on site at each visit or write warning letters in the event that there are further breaches.
- Write a warning letter for breaches stated above warning CHEC to submit documentation that are outstanding prior to further drilling activities.
- In the warning letter request: that marker buoys be put at coordinates where drilling should occur and more signs are put in place.
- Continue monitoring this site so that operation date is fully observed and proper sanctions can be made.
